

Chikungunya virus disease -- United States, 2014
Provisional data reported to ArboNET
Tuesday, July 29, 2014

Chikungunya is not a nationally notifiable disease in the United States. However, chikungunya cases can be reported to ArboNET, the national surveillance system for arthropod-borne diseases. This update from the CDC Arboviral Disease Branch includes provisional data reported to ArboNET for **January 1 – July 29, 2014**.

As of July 29, a total of 601 chikungunya virus disease cases have been reported to ArboNET from U.S. states and territories (Table, page 2). Two hundred and three locally-transmitted cases have been reported from Florida, Puerto Rico, and the US Virgin Islands. All other cases occurred in travelers returning from affected areas in the Caribbean or South America (N=391), the Pacific Islands (N=5), or Asia (N=2).

Figure. Chikungunya virus disease cases reported by state or territory – United States, 2014 (as of July 29, 2014)

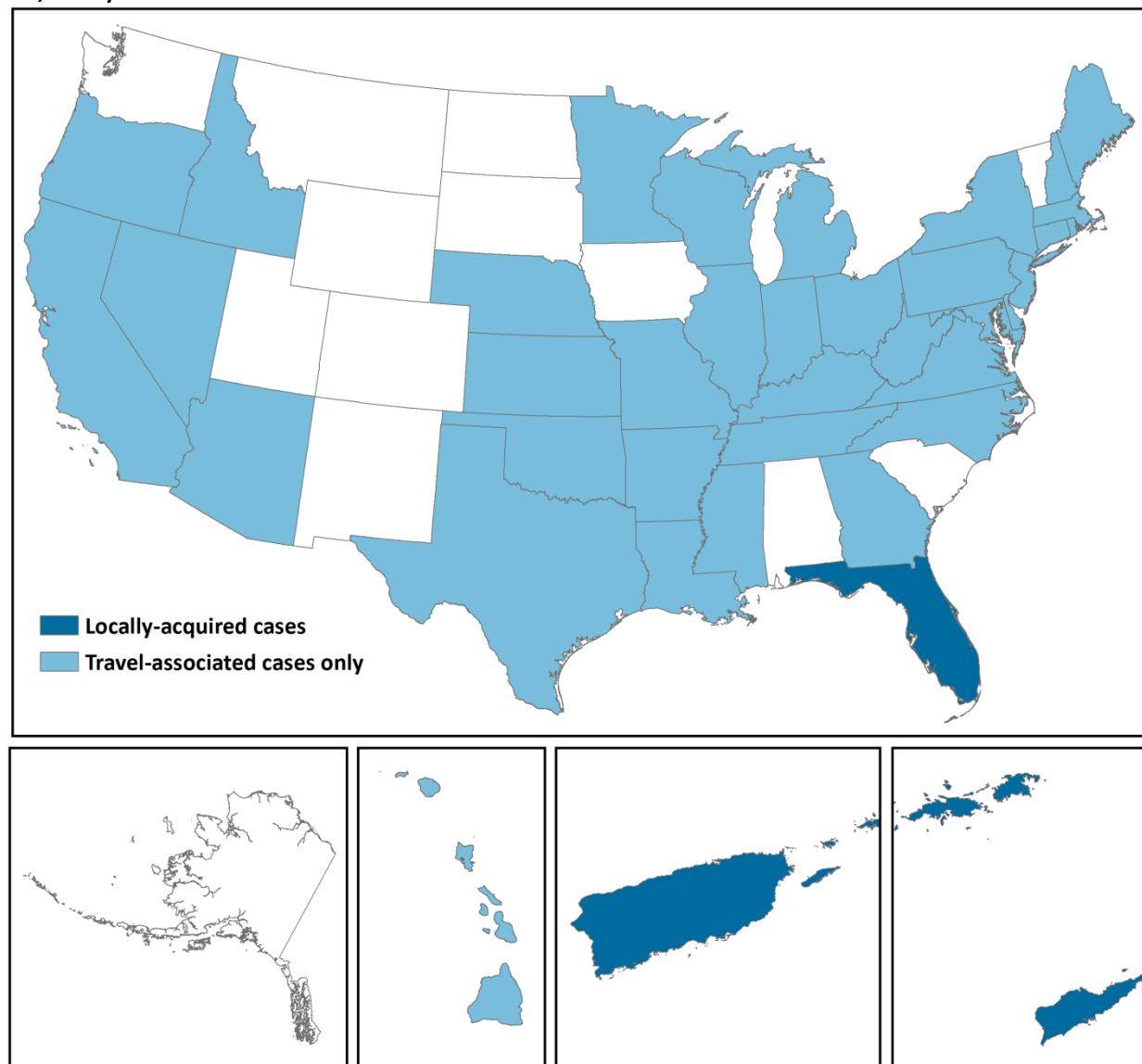
