At 4:00pm, Joe called the meeting to order.

The Town received a grant in the amount of \$4,064.17 through the Secretary of State office to cover the cost of absentee ballots for the November election. At 4:02pm, Vanessa made a motion to accept unanticipated funds from the grant in the amount of \$4,064.17. Bob seconded Joe took a roll call vote. Vanessa voted yes, Bob voted yes, and Joe voted yes. The motion passes.

The Board discussed the budget and encumbering funds. There is still come cushion that has been left for payroll and emergencies and there is approximately \$140,000.00 remaining in the budget for 2020. The Board reviewed and discussed possible purchases and encumbrances.

- At 4:13pm, Vanessa made a motion to encumber \$94,250.00 for the Police Department for the purchase of 2 police cruisers, the Watchguard system, and Microsoft Azure. Bob seconded. Joe took a roll call vote. Vanessa voted yes, Bob voted yes, and Joe voted yes. The motion passes.
- At 4:14pm, Bob made a motion to encumber \$1,415.32 for the cabinet and desk for the Police Department. Vanessa seconded. Joe took a roll call vote. Vanessa voted yes, Bob voted yes, and Joe voted yes. The motion passes.
- At 4:15pm, Vanessa made a motion to encumber \$5,742.51 for stonework in the cemetery. Bob seconded. Joe took a roll call vote. Vanessa voted yes, Bob voted yes, and Joe voted yes. The motion passes.
- At 4:15pm, Bob made a motion to encumber \$33,625.00 for the roof repair, fire gear, gear dryer, and tablets for the Fire Department and Emergency Management. Vanessa seconded. Joe took a roll call vote. Vanessa voted yes, Bob voted yes, and Joe voted yes. The motion passes.

A total of \$135,032.83 was encumbered.

There was discussion on the municipal accounting software. The money hasn't yet been fully spent and was appropriated separately in a warrant article that was approved by voters in March. The software hasn't been fully installed yet and will start the second week in January. At 4:18pm, Vanessa made a motion to encumber \$32,200.00 for municipal accounting software. Bob seconded. Joe took a roll call vote. Vanessa voted yes, Bob voted yes, and Joe voted yes. The motion passes.

The Board will discuss the warrant articles, Land Use Clerk position, and the Deliberative session at the meeting on January 4th.

There has been a request from the Supervisors of the Checklist to use the Town Hall for a meeting. Chief True feels this can be done safely and he will be there to supervise. The Board had no objections.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:26pm.
