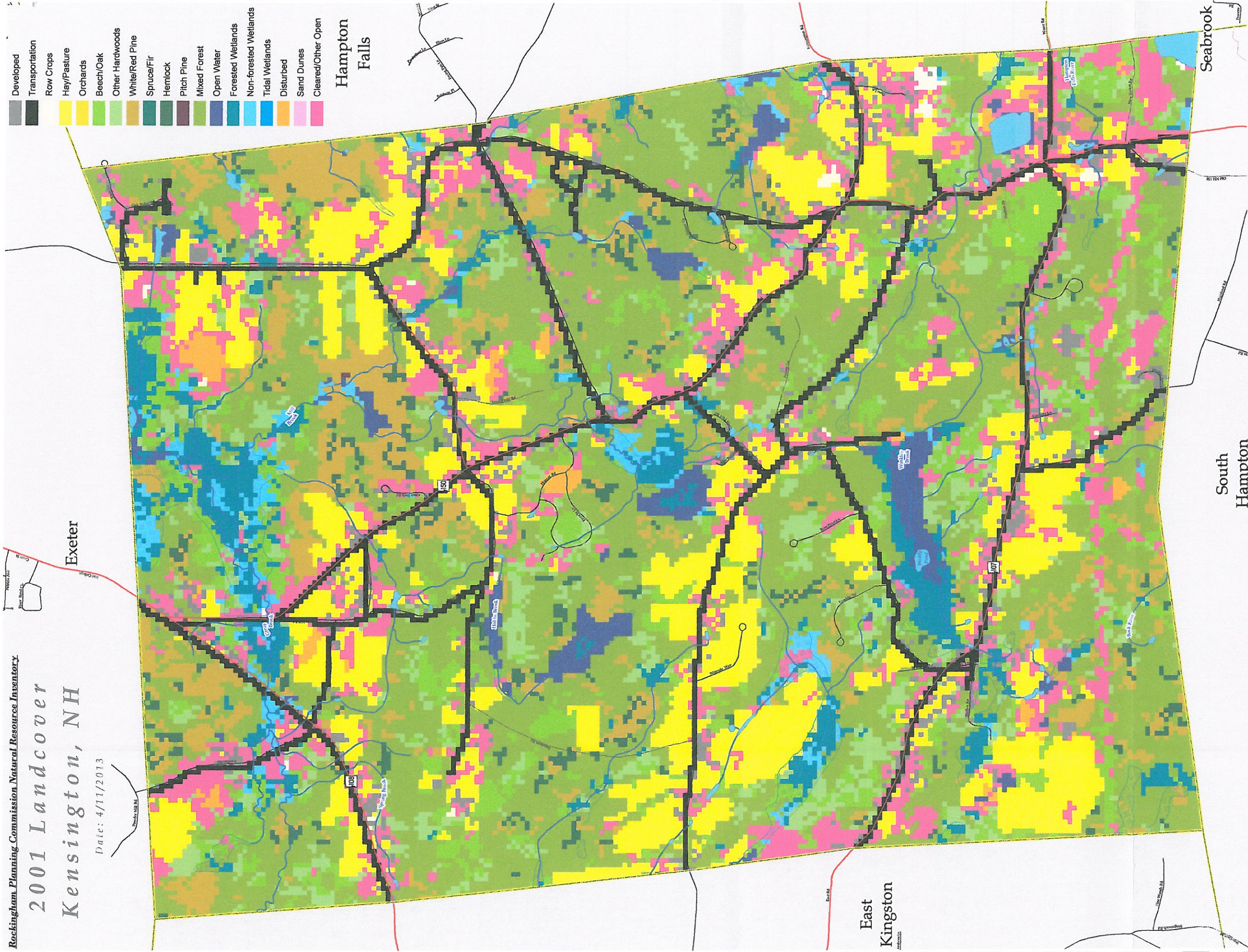

The Coastal New Hampshire Land Cover and Land Use data set categorizes land cover and land use into 19 classes, based largely on the classification of Landsat Thematic Mapper (TM) imagery. It covers the southeastern portion of the state (primarily Rockingham and Strafford counties). The goal of the Coastal New Hampshire Land Cover and Land Use data set is to provide a consistent data set to support regional and local planning efforts. The imagery used to produce this dataset was collected over a range of years from 1990 to 2001.
