Business discussed:

1. Welcome Sarah Hoffmaster as a new member to the Recreation Committee!
2. Summer Camp –
 - a. Hours – Drop off between 8 and 8:30 pick up 2:00 and 4:00 for extended day.
 - b. There will be 6 themed weeks this year – Kelsey to work on themes.
 - c. Bus for Field trips – Bus company is very expensive. Leslie to contact Carin's Caravans to see if they can do a better rate. Can they transport children? Do they have proper insurance?
 - d. Bouncy House days – Donna to contact Airzone for rates.
 - e. School use form – Jodi to complete form so that the campers can use the school multi purpose room more frequently.
3. Turkey Raffle – Sharee & Dave of Boogalow's had a Thanksgiving Day raffle for a Jamaican Smoked Turkey. They donated \$227.00 to the Kensington Recreation Committee for the Fireworks Fund!
