To qualify for the elderly exemption the applicant must be at least 65 years old on April 1st of the tax year (for a married couple, the eldest should apply), a New Hampshire resident for the past five years of the tax year applying and the property in which the exemption is claimed must be the principal residence. **Applications must be received in the Assessor's office by April 15, 2023.**

Net Income Limitations:

A. Single \$42,000.00 B. Married \$49,500.00

Asset Limitation:

\$200,000 (Excluding the value of the applicant's residence up to two (2) acres of land with the residence)

Exemptions:

Age 65-74 \$ 155,000.00 75-79 \$ 180,000.00 80 + \$ 200,000.00
