SNOW EMERGENCY ORDINANCE

In the event of a predicted or ongoing severe winter snowstorm requiring enhanced actions maintaining snow plowing and/or removal as deemed necessary by the Kensington Board of Selectmen or their designee, a Snow Emergency shall be called by the Chief of Police. The chief shall contact the news media, including local radio station to notify the public that a ban exists and shall specify a start of the snow emergency and shall estimate when same will be called off. It shall be unlawful for any person having the custody and/or control of any vehicle to park or cause the same to be parked within the public right of way during a snow emergency. Vehicles interfering with snowplowing and removal operations shall be towed and stored at owners expense.

Validity - If any section or part of a section, or paragraph of this Article is declared invalid or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect any other section or sections, or part of a section or paragraph of this ordinance. **Adopted at Town Meeting March 1993**
