EMERGENCY MEETING MINUTES
March 31, 2014
APPROVED APRIL 7, 2014**

In attendance: Russell Perry, Scott Lowell and Norman DeBoisbriand were in attendance. Russell called the meeting to order at 7:45pm.

***This meeting was not taped. With the change in location and equipment limitations, on April 2, 2012 the selectmen made a decision to discontinue tape recording the meetings as it is not required by state statute.**

The Board held an emergency meeting to discuss the air quality issues at the town offices. The staff was evacuated on Wednesday, March 26th after strong fumes were making the employees ill. The cause of the fumes was due to the adjacent business applying multiple coats of paint to a boat. The selectmen agreed since there was still an odor in the building after trying to air it out, they will have the air tested before allowing the staff back into the building.

Pam has been sending people to East Kingston for their auto registrations. Carlene's tax liens are due this week and she needs to be open. The staff left their cell phone numbers posted on the door for anyone that needed immediate help.

Russell Perry moved to adjourn at 8:45pm, seconded by Scott with all in favor.
