- 1. We discussed different methods of accepting donations for the charrette, and decided to use two methods. 1. An online site, YouCaring.com, which would use PayPal and a credit card link, and 2. Accept checks made out to Plan NH (Kensington Charrette on the memo line) sent to Frank Whittemore, 5 Hobbs Road, Kensington, NH 03833. We will need to create a tidy system to make this easy for Plan NH when we turn it all over at the Charrette.
- 2. Lynne and Elaine will meet with PlanNH tomorrow at 8 am at the library for a tour of the town center. Plan NH needs to decide which professionals would be most appropriate for Kensington. Update: Lynne and Elaine met with Robin LeBlanc. (Other committee members and the selectmen were not available.) We toured the Grange, (perfect! She said.) and the Hilliard-Prescott House, and drove around the center. After that we sat in the library with Susie and went over logistics. We will need to figure out how to rent a small bus for instance.
- 3. Public information efforts so far include the Community News article, Kathy Bailey's article for the Newsletter, a flyer for distribution at the Historical Society Yard Sale.
 - We will discuss populating the Facebook page and our page on the town site. Lynne has photos
 of the children's mural at the Farm and historic photos and building write-ups that can be

 - Maybe a big banner to hang on the cemetery fence?
 - We are asking Jim Webber to make buttons with our slogan: Your voice. Your vision. Your town
 on a "banner". With Kensington, Plan NH Charrette and the dates around the circle all on top of
 the town seal picture.
- 4. Having the school children do an art project involving their concept of our town center in the future would be a wonderful way to get them involved. We can hang the results at the Charrette.
