

Article 01 Operating Budget

Shall the Kensington School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$3,399,196? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$3,274,233, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Kensington School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. The Kensington School Board Recommends \$3,399,196.

Article 02 Unanticipated Special Education Expenses

To see if the Kensington School District will vote to raise and appropriate \$10,000 to be placed in the Special Education Expendable Trust Fund previously established for the unanticipated special education costs at Kensington Elementary School. This sum to come from June 30 fund balance available for transfer on July 1. No additional amount to be raised from taxation. The Kensington School Board Recommends this appropriation. Article 03 Building Repairs and Maintenance

To see if the Kensington School District will vote to raise and appropriate \$10,000 to be placed in the Repair and Maintenance Expendable Trust Fund previously established for building maintenance costs at Kensington Elementary School.
