~~PROPOSED ORDER~~

A petition for the appointment of individuals to fill vacancies on the Kensington Board of Selectmen was filed by Harold Bragg in the office of the clerk of the Superior Court on September 12, 2018. Upon reviewing the Verified Petition and exhibits attached thereto, the Court finds that, three vacancies have occurred, as that term is defined under RSA 652:12, on the three member Board of Selectmen for the Town of Kensington ("Town") as of September 11, 2018. Harold Bragg, a citizen of the Town, who also serves as the Town's Moderator, has petitioned this Court to appoint two suitable persons to fill the vacancies on the Town's Board of Selectmen, as no selectmen remain to make appointments to fill the vacancies. The Court finds there exists due cause to appoint successor interim selectmen under the Court's authority provided by RSA 669:63.



It is hereby ordered, adjudged, and decreed that the following individuals are appointed to the office of Selectmen for the Town of Kensington to serve in such position as of the date of this Order until the Town's Annual Meeting in March, 2019, at which time such appointment shall expire: Michael Schwotzer of 49 Cottage Road, Kensington, New Hampshire and Benjamin Cole of 242 North Haverhill Road, Kensington, New Hampshire.

The above appointments are conditioned upon such individuals taking the oath of office required under RSA 669:9.
