Old business:

- 1. Cemetery maintenance
 - a. Mowing Cemetery hasn't been mowed yet this year. Jackie asked Kathy to nag the contractor to get it mowed before Memorial Day.
 - b. Stone repair Jackie has asked Gravestone Services for an ETA on when they'll begin work on the Upper Yard stones.
 - c. Fence quotes No other quotes besides CertaPro have been received for the fence painting.
 - Jackie moved that the trustees accept the Certapro proposal for \$7886.69 (preliminary quote) pending Selectboard approval of reallocating the additional \$886.69 from the cemetery's tree maintenance budget allocation.

- 1. Cemetery mapping
 - a. The trustees were joined by Andy Roberts, who responded to Jackie's Facebook post seeking help with an update and improvement to the cemetery plot maps. Andy and the trustees enjoyed a lively discussion of the needs and requirements of a new cemetery map and some of the different possible approaches that could be taken. Andy is off to brainstorm how the project might best be framed and approached and will come back to the trustees with some suggestions.
