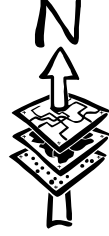


Aquifer Protection District

The Aquifer Protection District for Kensington is delineated as part of two SGS Aquifer study areas. The reference publications are: Geohydrology and Water Quality of Stratified-Aquifers in the Exeter, Lamprey, and Oyster River Basins, Southeastern New Hampshire, 1990 and Geohydrology and Water Quality of Stratified-Drift Aquifers in the Lower Merrimack and Coastal River Basins, Southeastern New Hampshire, 1992. Each publication includes a map which defines the aquifer area by identifying the aquifer transmissivity. The respective maps are titled "Saturated Thickness and Transmissivity of Stratified Drift in the Exeter, Lamprey, and Oyster River Basins, Southeastern New Hampshire" and "Saturated Thickness, Transmissivity and Materials of Stratified Drift Aquifers in the Lower Merrimack and Coastal River Basins, Southeastern New Hampshire".
