ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF TOWN ROADS

Adopted by the Board of Selectmen June 2, 2003

1. AUTHORITY – In accordance with the authority granted by Chapter 41:11 and any other applicable Chapter or Amendment thereto of the NH Revised Statutes Annotated, the following Ordinance is hereby adopted by the Kensington Board of Selectmen to regulate the use of town roads.
2. RULES AND REGULATIONS:
 - a. A permit is required for any and all races or events traveling over roads in Kensington.

* Deposit will be returned following certification by the Police Department that the above stipulations have been fully complied with.

- b. Painting or marking of the roads in any permanent way is prohibited.
- c. Temporary markings, ex., chalk, or paper signs may be permitted but must be cleaned up following the event.
- d. No littering is permitted.
- e. A deposit of \$50.00 must be submitted with the application for permit. Deposit will be refunded if the above rules and regulations are fully complied with as certified by the Kensington Police Department.
- 3. PENALTY: Any person(s) violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be liable to a penalty of not more than \$100.00 for each offense.
- 4. VALIDITY: If any section or part of a section or paragraph of this Ordinance is declared invalid, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force or effect of this other section or sections or part of a section or paragraph of this Ordinance.
