Meeting 6:30pm

At 6:30pm J. Pace called the meeting to order.

The Board reviewed the minutes of November 15th, 2021. J. Pace turned the meeting over to B. Solomon, recused himself and approached the podium to address the Board as a private citizen. He discussed the Board meeting of November 15th. He suggested to the Board the language “Mr. Pace and Mr. Brandano engaged in a brief and heated exchange for which Mr. Pace promptly apologized and Mr. Brandano gracefully accepted.” would be appropriate to add to the minutes. He noted that he yielded his privilege to vote on the final form of the language and left it to the discretion of the Board. He stated that this was to ensure there was no conflict of interest or undue influence attached to the final draft of the minutes.

New Business

At 6:36pm B. Solomon made a motion to accept the bid from Doug’s Tree service for \$4,100. B. Gustafson seconded. All voted in favor.

- Background Checks - Kathleen had spoken to Police Chief Cain about the new online offering. This would be for non-law enforcement hires.

At 6:38pm B. Gustafson made a motion to approve the agreement and authorize the Chair to sign for the Board for the requirements of the background checks. B. Solomon seconded. All voted in favor.

At 6:40pm B. Solomon made a motion to accept the bid for Sanders Searches, LLC renewal contract for \$200. B. Gustafson seconded. All voted in favor.

Police Chief Cain noted that cars have been broken into and would like to remind residents to please make sure their vehicles are locked.

At 6:45pm B. Solomon made a motion to accept the minutes of the November 8th joint meeting of the Sawyer Park Trust. B. Gustafson seconded. All voted in favor.

The board signed off on bills and payroll.

The Board discussed a possible Warrant Article for a wildlife mitigation fund.

At 6:49pm B. Solomon made a motion to enter a non-public meeting under RSA 91A:3 II (I). B. Gustafson seconded. All voted in favor.
