

# How To Apply for a Marriage License

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Both in state and out of state residents may apply at any City or Town Clerk's Office to be married in the State of New Hampshire.
- Blood tests are not required.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- To apply for the license, both parties must appear at the same time in the office or the application cannot be completed.

## FEES INVOLVED

- The filing fee of \$50.00, payable to the Town of Kensington, is to be paid at the time of application. Payment will be by check or cash; no credit or debit card payment can be accepted.

## LICENSING TIME FRAME

- The license is valid for ninety (90) days from the date you apply. There is no longer a waiting period and the license can be used the same day.

## IDENTIFICATION

- A government issued photo identification is required of both parties at the time of application.

## ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED

- If either party was married previously, the following must be presented, as applicable:

**DIVORCE:** A certified copy of the final divorce decree with a raised seal.

**DEATH:** A certified copy of the death certificate with a raised seal.

**ANNULMENT:** A certified copy of the annulment certificate with a raised seal.
