ARTICLES

Article 01 Operating Budget

Shall the Kensington School District raise and appropriate as an operating budget, not including appropriations by special warrant articles and other appropriations voted separately, the amounts set forth on the budget posted with the warrant or as amended by vote of the first session, for the purposes set forth therein, totaling \$4,372,467? Should this article be defeated, the default budget shall be \$4,269,228, which is the same as last year, with certain adjustments required by previous action of the Kensington School District or by law; or the governing body may hold one special meeting, in accordance with RSA 40:13, X and XVI, to take up the issue of a revised operating budget only. The Kensington School Board Recommends \$4,372,467. (Majority vote required)

Article 02 Unanticipated Special Education Expenses

Shall the Kensington School District vote to raise and appropriate up to \$10,000 to be placed in the Special Education Expendable Trust Fund previously established for the unanticipated special education costs at Kensington Elementary School? This sum to come from June 30 fund balance available for transfer on July 1. No additional amount to be raised from taxation. The Kensington School Board recommends this appropriation. (Majority vote required)

Article 03 Building Repairs and Maintenance

Shall the the Kensington School District vote to raise and appropriate up to \$10,000 to be placed in the Repair and Maintenance Expendable Trust Fund previously established for building maintenance costs at Kensington Elementary School? This sum to come from June 30 fund balance available for transfer on July 1. No additional amount to be raised from taxation. The Kensington School Board recommends this appropriation. Article 04 Technology Trust Fund

Shall the Kensington School District vote to establish a Technology Capital Reserve Fund under the provisions of RSA 35:1 for unanticipated technology expenses and to raise and appropriate up to \$5,000 to be placed in this fund. This sum to come from June 30 fund balance available for transfer on July 1. No additional amount to be raised from taxation. Further, to name the Kensington School Board as agents to expend from the fund. The Kensington School Board recommends approval. (Majority vote required)
